### LOCAL ACCESS

**Spadina Ave:** will remain **OPEN** all day for uninterrupted North-South traffic and Gardiner Expressway access. This is the **BEST** way in and out of the city.

**Dundas St:** will remain **OPEN** all day for uninterrupted East-West traffic. Access is available to all cross-streets north of Dundas St.

**Don Valley Parkway:** southbound traffic can use Richmond St exit. However, if heading west of Church St, traffic must head north to Dundas St (or beyond) to continue westbound.

**NOTE:** Paid-duty police officers will be at all major intersections to safely direct traffic through gaps in the runners. Please expect some delays.
